We are very excited to host our 7th Annual Custer County Cowboy Gathering Chuck Wagon Cook-Off at A Painted View Ranch in Westcliffe, CO. We are striving to make this event an enjoyable experience for families, as well as wagon crews. Please join us for cowboy church on Sunday morning from 10:00am-11:30am and the music performances from 11:30am-?pm. Concessions will be available Saturday and Sunday.

The Chuck Wagon Camp will be located in the front paddock of A Painted View Ranch Arena. The charge for the electrical hookup is \$25.00 per night. Non-RV parking will be located within a short walking distance (after unloading the wagons) of the chuck wagon camp.

Wagon check-in will be on Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup> from 12:00pm to 5:00pm. Wagon sites will be issued at check in. The wagon judging will begin Friday, August 18<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm. The cook's meeting will follow the judging and will be in the Ranch's Cantina with A Painted View Ranch providing a complimentary meet and greet dinner.

All dry goods and water will be distributed to the wagons after the cook's meeting on Friday. Cold items will be distributed to each wagon Saturday morning from 8:00am to 9:00am along with plates, napkins, plastic ware and cups. Drinks will be provided for ticket holders. You will be provided the necessary ingredients to prepare the following meal: chicken fried steak (tenderized once), potatoes, beans, bread or cornbread, and cobbler.

Each wagon will be furnished the following ingredients for up to 60 people

55 6 Oz. Cubed steaks	4 lbs. Sugar	8 lbs Fruit
6 lbs Pinto Beans (dried)	4 lbs onions	10 lbs all-purpose flour
20 lbs Potatoes	2 dozen eggs	2 gallon whole milk
6 lbs Crisco or Oil	2 lb Butter	10 gallons bottled water

**Note:** *Bagged ice will be provided*

Each wagon must furnish its own firewood for cooking, food thermometer

and bleach. Water for clean-up will be provided on site. Each camp will be provided containers for their food entries which will be presented at the designated area to be judged at 4:45pm. Food entrees will be judged on taste and appearance and all cooking must be done on site. No Propane or Gas stoves will be permitted. The general public will be invited to purchase food tickets for the meals prepared by the chuck wagon cooks.

Providing there is no fire ban in August, conversation firewood will be provided.

Wagon authenticity judging will begin at 5:30pm on Friday. We will have judges for both the sanctioned authenticity of wagons and food judging.

The awards program will be during the intermission of the concert on Saturday evening. Wagons may leave after the awards presentations, but are encouraged to stay overnight and depart Sunday morning.
